Jordan liked the idea of making his own money and so he earned money by selling snacks to friends in his neighborhood.

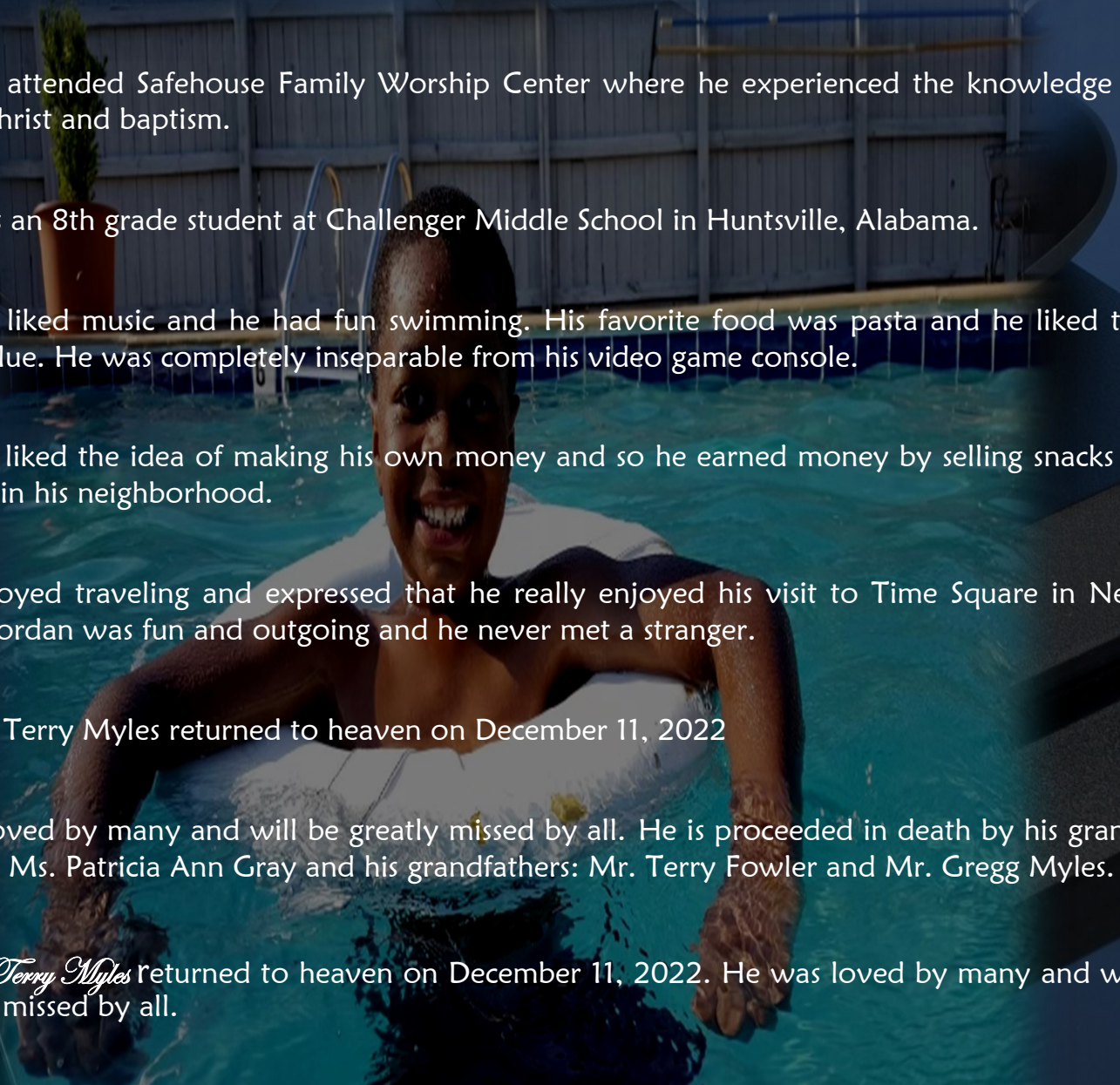
He enjoyed traveling and expressed that he really enjoyed his visit to Time Square in New York. Jordan was fun and outgoing and he never met a stranger.
