MICHAEL JERMAINE ANDERS was born on June 8, 1993 in Huntsville, Alabama to Robert Anders, Sr. and Theresa Matthews Anders. At an early age, he committed his life to Christ and joined Chelsea Cumberland Presbyterian Church in America. Later, he and the family united with Church Street Cumberland Presbyterian Church in America. He departed this life on November 16, 2023.

Forever the seeker, Michael came before the Church and rededicated himself to God on March 20, 2023. He served God and man through numerous ministries in the church and is most noted for his gift of Mime Liturgical Dance. This gift allowed him the opportunity to display a range of emotions and praise God through dance. Members and friends of Church Street will long remember his “Break Every Chain” performance.

Michael received his formal education in the public schools of Huntsville, graduating from Butler High School in 2012. He was a star basketball player at Butler High, helping to guide the team to the finals of the Alabama State 6A Championship during his senior year. During Michael’s robust life, he enjoyed the experiences gained and friendships made in his varied employment venues. In his years as bus driver for Huntsville City Schools, he considered the students and their parents as ‘extended family.’ He often spoke of the knowledge gained from his experience with the Mercedes Company in Tuscaloosa and Toyota of Huntsville, Alabama.

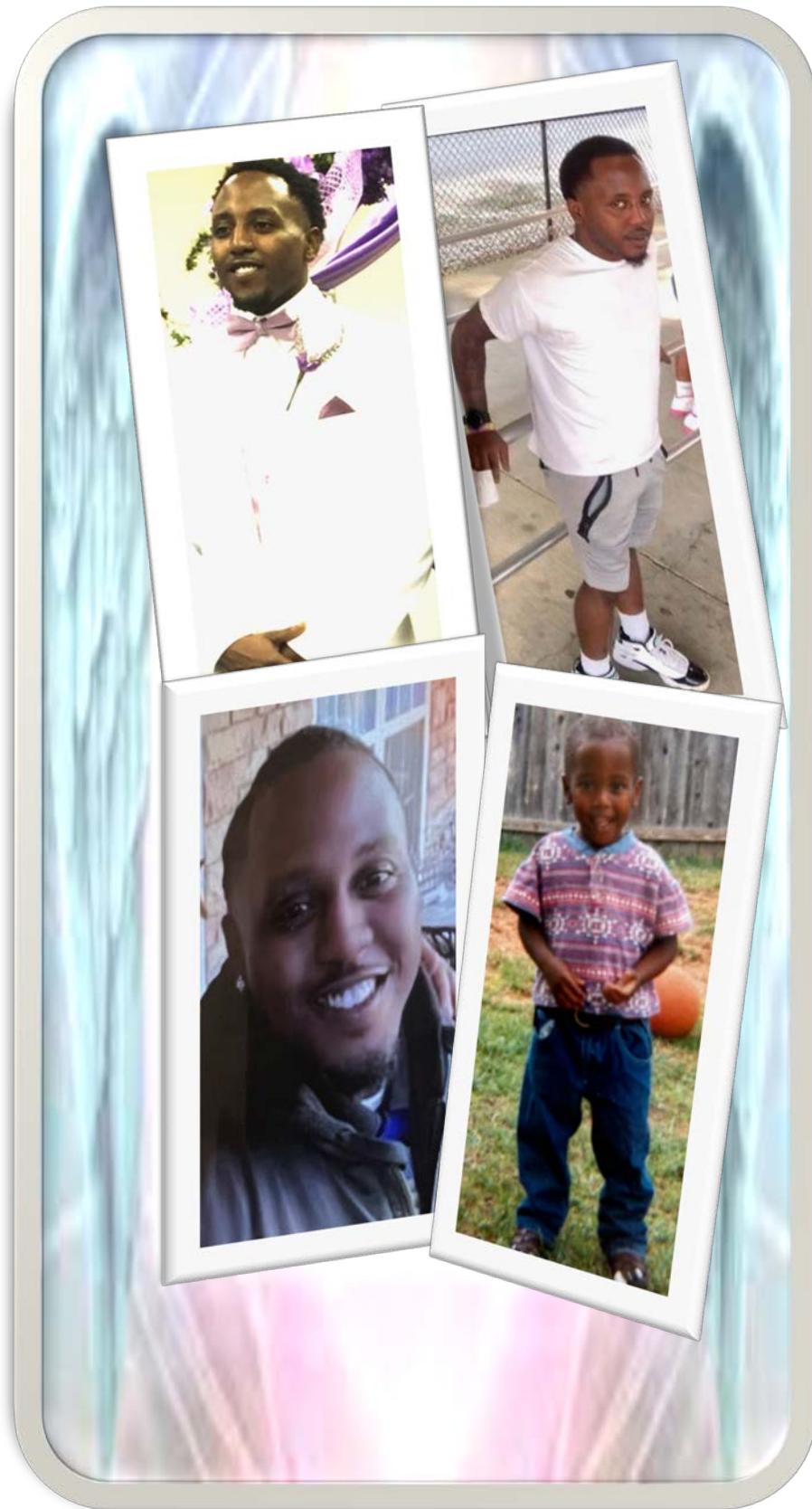
